The weather was a challenge at the beginning, but it brightened up and the rest of the afternoon stayed dry.

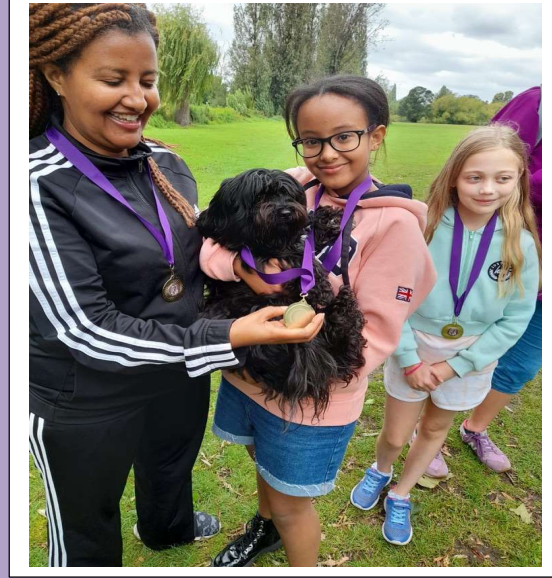

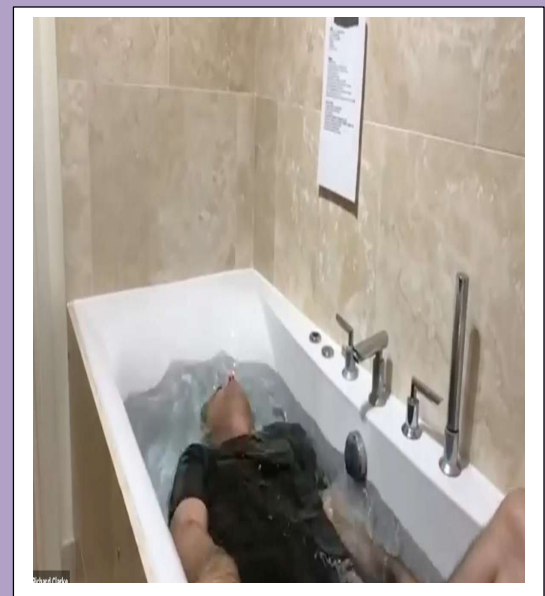
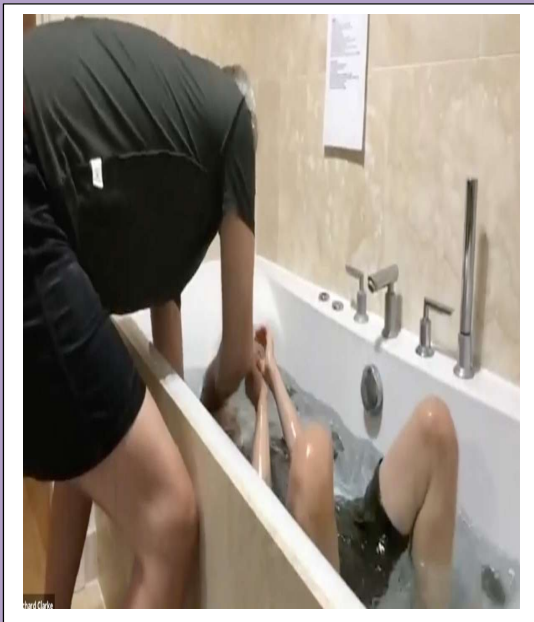


### **SPONSORED WALK FOR NEW ZION'S WORLDWIDE PROJECTS.**

New Zion is a ministry that started in 2005 where Healing Centres were opened up in various parts of the world. Mostly in developing countries. This ministry opened our eyes to the desperate needs of thousands around the world. How can we even start to help? As Mother Theresa used to say... "one at a time". To date New Zion have sponsors who have helped 19 families move from a slum area and into a decent one-bedroom house with a kitchen and toilet and into jobs of their own giving them their dignity back as they learn to provide for their own family. Also, 11 abandoned or orphaned Children are being sponsored and cared for. These funds clothe, feed and educate each child. Then there is a feeding program in Durban S.Africa that reaches street children and extremely poor families. Projects also include helping those in need here in the UK.

A Big Thank you to the 14 people who turned out on the day of the sponsored walk, 11 of them walked around the lake at Danson Park, here in the South of UK, whilst 2 people completed the sponsored walk in the Midlands also here in the UK. Another walk was supposed to happen in Bangalore India, but the Coronavirus is still a big problem there and they are still on serious lockdown. Those of you who walked really did deserve a medal.
